

**Notes from the Student Services**  
**March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010.**

1. **East Pictou Education Foundation** – Several bursaries will be awarded to students who are currently living in a rural community in Pictou East. Applications are available from Student Services and the deadline for application is May 11, 2010.
2. **deGarthe Art Scholarship** – Applicants must be 2010 graduates of a Nova Scotia high school intending on entering studies in Art in a duly recognized program of higher learning in the school year following the awarding of the scholarship. Applicants must submit two (2) unframed original artworks. Information and applications are available from Student Services. Deadline for application is April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
3. **ICANS High School Scholarship Program** – The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nova Scotia (ICANS) is pleased to offer four \$1,000 awards to Nova Scotian high school students who are graduating in June 2009 and attending university in September 2010 to pursue a Bachelor's Degree in Business of Commerce. Information and applications are available in Student Services. Deadline for application is April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2010.
4. **The Nova Scotia Health Research Foundation (NSHRF) Decade Award** – One award of \$10,000 will be given to each school board. The objective of the scholarship is to encourage youth in Nova Scotia to understand the value of the health research conducted in the province and to understand the impact health research has on individuals, communities and the province. To be eligible for this award, you must be a graduate of a NS high school in the 2009-10 school year; a resident of Nova Scotia; and a student who is entering the first year at t Nova Scotia university or community college in the fall of 2010. Information and applications are available from Student Services and are due by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010.
5. **Nova Scotia/Nunavut Command - The Royal Canadian Legion** - A number of bursaries are available to graduating grade 12 students who will be entering first year of university, community college or trade school. These must be mailed after the student has graduated in June and include a final transcript. Applications are available from Student Services. Deadline for application is July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
