

Notes from Student Services

1. **Royal Canadian Legion and the Thomas R.G. Rogers Bursaries** – Four bursaries, valued at \$800.00, will be awarded to students who plan to pursue post-secondary studies. These students must have a connection with the Legion through family and/or ideals as well as monetary need. Deadline for application is April 30th, 2010.
2. **The Rear Admiral Leonard Warren Murray Bursary** – A bursary of at least \$500 in memory of Rear Admiral Leonard Warren Murray will be awarded to a student in Pictou County who has maintained a commendable average and is furthering his/her education. Applications are available in Student Services and are due on May 31st, 2010.
3. **Nova Scotia Freemasons Scholarship - Euclid Lodge #92** – One bursary of \$1000.00 will be awarded to a deserving student who fulfils the criteria. This award will be awarded to a student enrolled in a degree-granting institution (university) or Community College located in Atlantic Canada.
